University of Delhi (Scholarship Cell)

"Man Mohan Kishan Kaul Scholarships"

- 1. There shall be two scholarships called "Man Mohan Kishan Kaul Scholarships' each of the value of Rs.100/- p.m. payable out of the annual income accruing on the property donated to the University by Late Pt. Man Mohan Kishan Kaul to be awarded annually to the deserving and needy students whose parents income including his/her own income does not exceed the amount from where it starts attracting the income tax and who join the Ist year of B.E., (Electrical/Electronics/Mechanical/Civil) Engineering courses in the University.
- 2. The number of scholarships to be awarded each year shall be determined on the basis of the income available for award of scholarships after the payment of Rs.1200/- p.a. to the Blind Relief Association as per the will and also meeting the expenditure on maintenance of the property.
- Each scholarship shall be tenable for 4 years renewable yearly on the basis of satisfactory performance of the awardee.
- No student shall be eligible for a scholarship if he/she is in receipt of any other scholarship/financial assistance, other than freeship, from any other University/State Government/Central Government/Private Body.
- 5. In case a scholar accepts any other scholarship or financial assistance from any other source, the amount received from this fund will be refunded by him/her to the University from the date he/she accepts any other scholarship or financial assistance. The unutilized amount will be added to the corpus of the fund.
- 6. If it appears to the University at any time that a scholar is unable to show satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross misconduct or has been irregular in attendance, he/she shall, after due warning in writing, be reported by the Principal of his/her College to the Academic Council which may withdraw the scholarship.

Regulations:

- (a) Applications for scholarship should reach the Registrar, giving detailed information on the prescribed form by the date mentioned in the Notification issued, each year in this respect by the Registrar.
- (b) The scholarships shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendation of the Selection Committee constituted as follows:
 - 1. Dean, Faculty of Technology (Chairman)
 - 2. Principal, Delhi College of Engineering
 - 3. Dean, Faculty of Science.
