"GANGA SANT SCHOLARSHIP"

- 1. There shall be one Scholarship known as "Ganga Sant Scholarship" of the value of Rs.175/Jp.m. to be awarded out of the annual income accruing from the endowment fund of Rs. 50,000/- endowed by Sh. B.D.Manocha, C-79, South Extension, Part-II, New Delhi.
- 2. The scholarship shall be tenable for a period of three years, renewable yearly on the basis of satisfactory performance of the awardee.
- 3. The scholarship shall be awarded to a meritorious student who joins the first year of the B.A.(Hons) Course in Sanskrit and needs financial assistance for pursuing the course. In the event of no such student being available, the Scholarship shall be awarded to a student who joins the first year of the B.A.(Hons) course in Mathematics. In case no student is available in this course, the scholarship may be awarded to a meritorious student who joins the first year of any other Honours Course in the University and needs financial assistance.
- 4. (a) No student shall be eligible for this scholarship if he/she already holds any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, other than freeship.
 - (b) In case he/she accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on this account from the date he/she accepts the other scholarship/financial assistance.
- 5. If it should appear at any time during the tenure of the award that the scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross misconduct or has been irregular in attendance, he/she after due warning in writing, be reported by the Principal of his/her College to the Academic Council which may reduce, suspend or withdraw the scholarship.
- 6. The Scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendations of a Selection Committee constituted as follows:-
 - (i) The Dean, Faculty of Arts (Chairman)
 - (ii) The Head, Department of Sanskrit
 - (iii) The Head, Department of Mathematics
- 7. Applications for the scholarship, in the prescribed form obtainable from the office of the Registrar, (Scholarship Cell) should reach the Registrar, University of Delhi, Delhi-7, through the Principal of the concerned college by the date mentioned in the Notification issued by the Registrar in this behalf.
- 8. The payment of the scholarship amount shall be made to the scholar through the Principal of his/her college on presentation of a bill and a certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the bill the awardee was not in receipt of any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source.
- 9. The unutilised amount in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
